CNIA: A Story of Ongoing Success

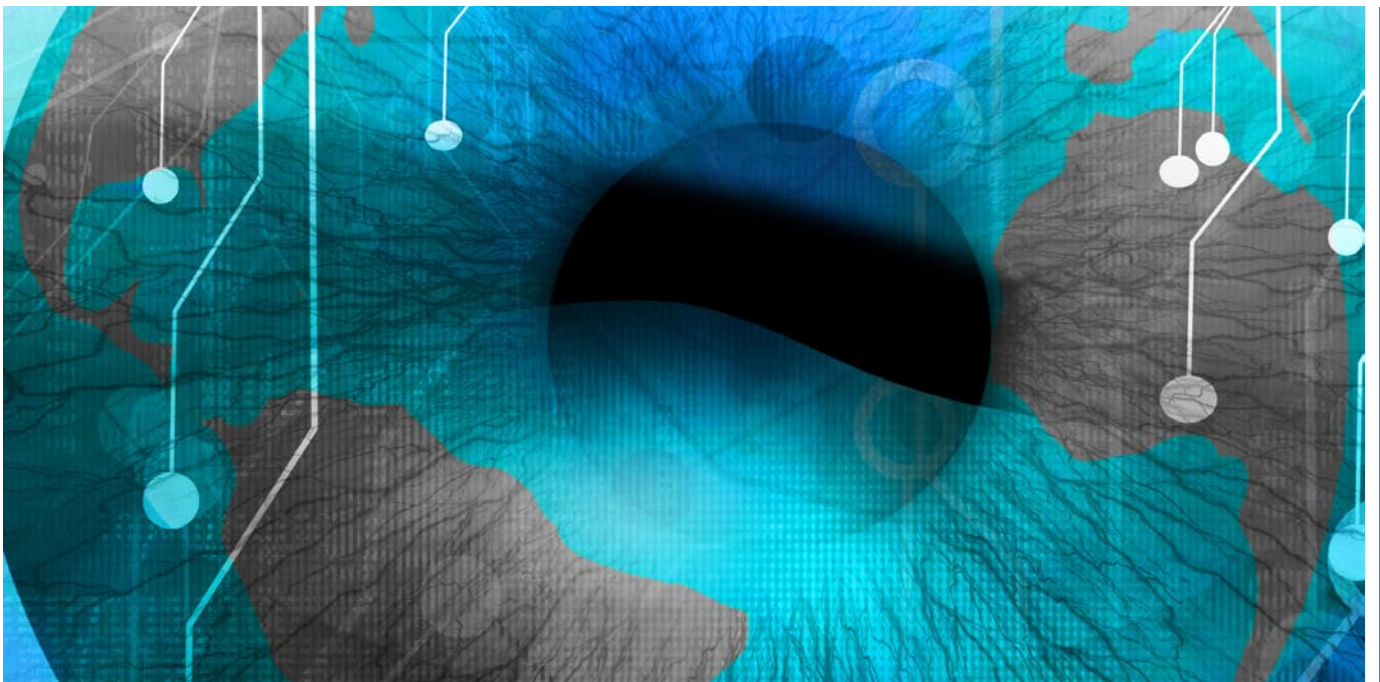

The MoU was signed in Dubai by Ahmed Rashid bin Fahad, Minister of Environment and Water, and Mohamed Nasser Al Ghanim, Director-General of TRA.

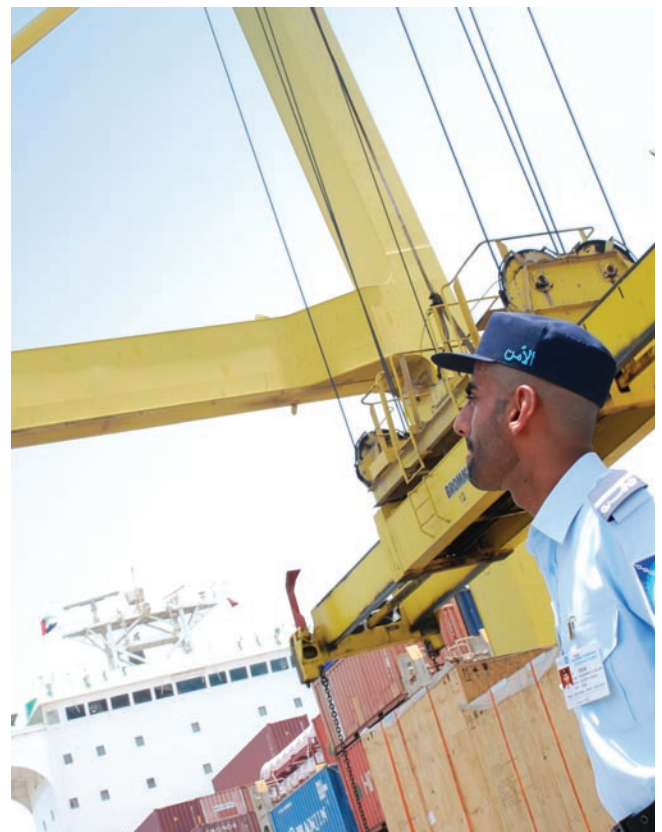

Milestones

The number of the container Teus handled at Abu Dhabi Terminals rose in the first quarter of 2009 to 104,762 compared with 88,240 in the first quarter of the last year. General cargo shipments also rose in the first half of 2009, up to 1,052,447 MT from 970,868 MT as compared to last year.

The number of the cruise vessels handled by ADT over the first quarter rose from 38 to 40. This has been translated into a larger number of tourists coming to Abu Dhabi, from 43,554 in the first quarter of 2008, to 63,154 tourists, registering a 45% growth rate.

By the year 2011 Abu Dhabi will open its new port in Taweelah. This is one of ADT's long-term goals which aim to expand business throughout the emirate of Abu Dhabi

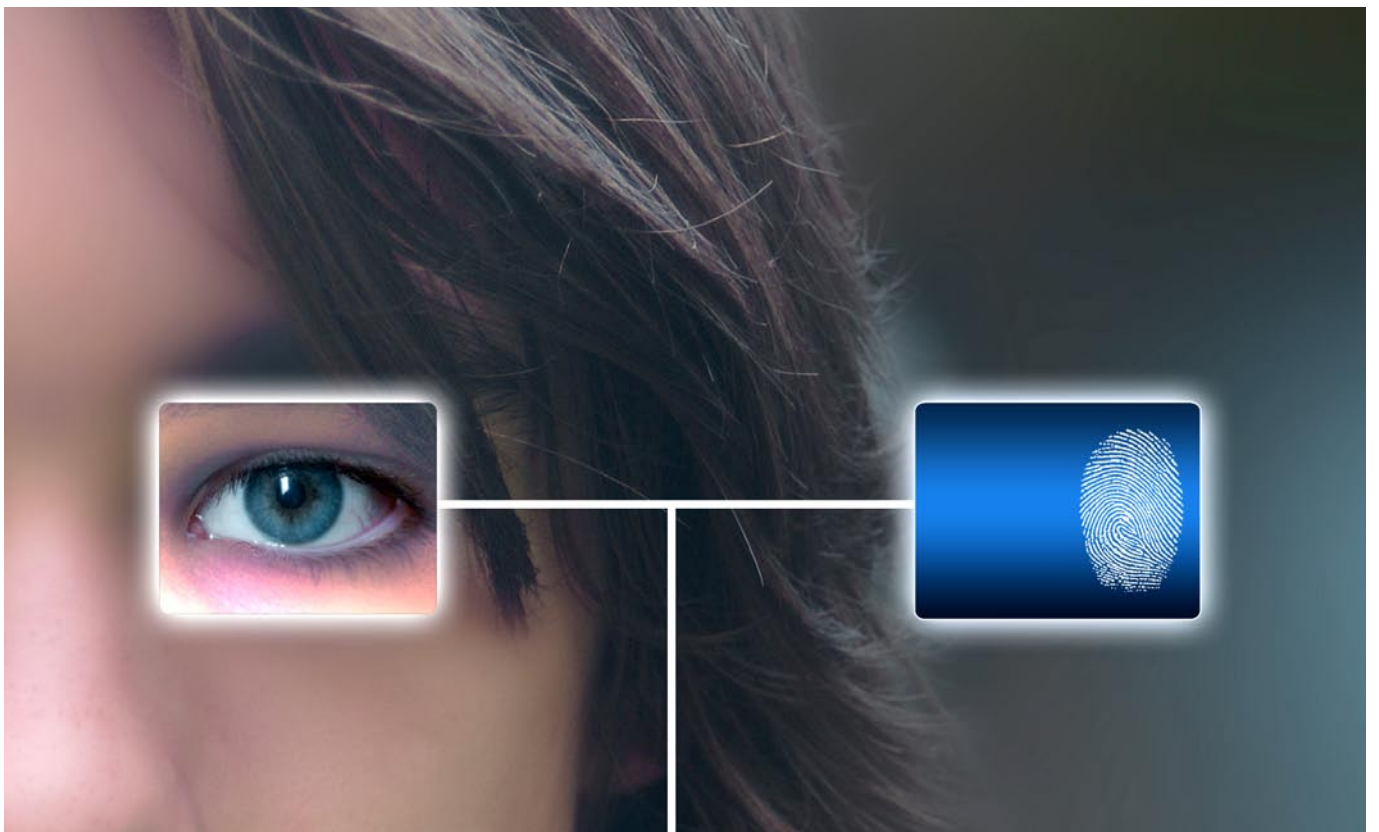

ولأن الرؤية أثمرت عن خطط متكاملة فقد نجح الجهاز منذ تأسيسه للآن على توفير كافة التدابير الضرورية والإجراءات الأمنية المطلوبة من خلال التنسيق مع مختلف الجهات الحكومية الأمنية المختصة لوضع الخطط والتدابير الأمنية اللازمة لإحباط كافة الأعمال التخريبية أو التي تشكل خطراً يهدد أمن تلك المنشآت والمرافق الحيوية أو يعيق استقرار وازدهار الدولة.
