## Tomorrow's Security is Built Today

This highlights the importance of ISNR 2026, which saw its largest participation yet, with 253 companies from 37 countries. The event serves as a vital platform for decision-makers, public and private institutions, and experts to showcase innovations, build partnerships, and enhance international cooperation in addressing future challenges.

This year's exhibition introduces several new initiatives, particularly the inaugural Abu Dhabi Global Sustainable Security Summit, which will discuss AI-powered governance, predictive security, and intelligence systems, reflecting rapid changes in global security.

At the core of these transformations are people, as technology alone is not enough. Effective utilisation comes from experience, expertise, and ongoing investment in human capital.

### ISNR 2026 Opens Its Largest-Ever Edition

Under the patronage of Lieutenant General His Highness Sheikh Saif bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of the Interior, the ninth edition of the International Exhibition for National Security and Resilience (ISNR) 2026 officially opened today at ADNEC Centre Abu Dhabi and will run until 21 May, 2026, with broad participation from government entities and leading international companies specialising in security, defence, and advanced technologies.

The exhibition is organised by ADNEC Group, a Modon company, in collabora-

tion with the Ministry of Interior and in strategic partnership with Abu Dhabi Police General Headquarters, Rabdan Academy, Tawazun Council for Defence Enablement as Strategic Enablement Partner, the Cyber Security Council as Cyber Security Partner, Presight as the AI Industry Leader, Abu Dhabi Convention & Exhibition Bureau as Destination Partner, PwC as Knowledge Partner, Secure Life Group as Gold Sponsor, and Aligned Edges as Silver Partner.

Held under the theme “Securing Tomorrow Today,” this edition marks the largest in the exhibition’s history in terms

of international participation, exhibition space, and the number of exhibitors. It reflects the UAE’s advanced position in supporting national security and resilience systems and attracts leading decision-makers, experts, and global companies specialising in advanced security technologies.

#### Record Growth

The ninth edition records remarkable growth across all key indicators, with the number of exhibitors increasing by 19% to 253 companies, compared with the

previous edition, and the total exhibition space expanding by 17% to exceed 28,000 square meters. This year’s edition also welcomes participation from 37 countries, including nine that are participating for the first time. National companies account for 60% of total exhibitors, compared with 40% for international companies, while SMEs represent 20% of participating exhibitors.

#### Global Summit

ISNR 2026 introduces the Abu Dhabi Global Sustainable Security Summit 2026, a three-day event featuring global security officials and experts. The summit will address the future of security and national preparedness amidst rapid technological change, focusing on themes such as AI-enabled governance, predictive security, and strengthening research partnerships to enhance resilience against evolving challenges.

The summit will host over 60 speakers from 15 countries, as well as national



and awareness domains, including the Disaster Victim Identification Team, the Security Event Management System (WEB-EOC), the Aman Platform, the Safe City Artificial Intelligence System, drones, and the Virtual Training Platform, along with specialised initiatives and interactive demonstrations.

The exhibition is also expected to see the announcement of several agreements and commercial deals, reinforcing ISNR’s role in supporting national industries, strengthening competitiveness, opening new partnership opportunities, and advancing knowledge transfer and localization, further cementing Abu Dhabi’s position as a global hub for security cooperation and innovation.

It highlights advancements in AI, cybersecurity, surveillance, emergency response, and critical infrastructure pro-

tection systems as the first line of defence for modern infrastructure, while providing practical insights into evolving cyber threats and advanced innovations in the cybersecurity field.

#### Specialised Features

ISNR 2026 introduces a range of new initiatives and specialised features, most notably the AI Security Forum, taking place for the first time as a strategic platform bringing together government leaders, security agencies, technology providers, and AI experts to discuss the impact of Artificial Intelligence on national security, cybersecurity, and policing.

The event will also host the “Code Breaker” Hackathon, offering participants realistic cybersecurity simulations that highlight the importance of digital pro-

tection systems as the first line of defence for modern infrastructure, while providing practical insights into evolving cyber threats and advanced innovations in the cybersecurity field.

In addition, the current edition features the ISNR Fitness Championship for the Civil Defence Challenge and Community Challenge categories, with the participation of 60 teams in the Firefighters category and 46 teams in the Community category, aiming to promote physical readiness, teamwork, discipline, and public awareness of the importance of fitness in enhancing operational preparedness.

**What is the significance of organising ISNR 2026 given the security and digital transformations the world is currently experiencing?**

The significance of the International Exhibition for National Security and Resilience (ISNR) 2026 lies in its capacity to integrate national security, digital security, and technological innovation amid rapid changes in the nature of risks. The exhibition has evolved beyond a mere showcase of solutions; it has become a strategic platform for dialogue, partnership development, and envisioning the future of security in an environment where physical and cyber threats are increasingly interconnected. Additionally, its presence in Abu Dhabi underscores the UAE's status as a regional and international hub for advanced security discussions, emphasizing its ability to convene experts and decision-makers around a collective mission to promote security, stability, and innovation.

**To what extent has international cooperation become necessary to confront cyber threats?**

International cooperation has transitioned from a supplementary option to a strategic necessity. Given that cyber threats are transnational and exceed traditional boundaries, effective responses require information sharing, standardisation, coordination, and trust among governments, the private sector, and international institutions. Specialised international platforms are crucial for fostering a shared understanding and promoting a more effective collective response.

**How have cyberattacks reshaped the concept of national security in recent years?**

Cyberattacks have significantly transformed the concept of national security. Security is no longer perceived merely in terms of physical protection or border integrity; it now also includes data safeguarding, service continuity, the resilience of digital infrastructure, and the maintenance of public trust. Any disruption to critical systems, services, or digital supply chains can have direct repercussions on economic and social stability. As a result, cybersecurity has become a vital component of the national security framework, rather than a distinct technical issue.

**Has Artificial Intelligence (AI) made cyber threats more complex?**

Indeed, while Artificial Intelligence has significantly enhanced protective capabilities, it has simultaneously introduced more intricate, rapid, and scalable threats. Attackers can leverage these tools to create more convincing phishing messages, refine deception techniques, expedite target analysis, and automate various stages of their attacks. On the other hand, AI equips defenders with advanced tools for early detection, behaviour analysis, and intelligent responses. This underscores that we are engaged in an ongoing race, where the emphasis is not only on adopting technology but also on managing and directing it securely and responsibly.

**Despite the development of protective systems, why do breaches persist globally?**

Cybersecurity is not a static product that can be acquired once; rather, it is an ongoing process influenced by shifting threats, advancing tools, and the growing array of digital platforms susceptible to attack. As security measures improve, so too do the methods employed by attackers. Moreover, vulnerabilities are

not solely inherent in the technology itself; often, they stem from human factors, improper configurations, a lack of timely updates, or the complexity and interconnectedness of the digital landscape. Thus, the most effective strategy remains a holistic approach that combines technology, governance, awareness, preparedness, and continuous testing of plans.

**How can we build a generation that is aware of cybersecurity and train young men and women to lead this sector?**

Fostering an informed generation starts with reshaping cybersecurity from a specialised topic into a cultural norm and an invaluable skill for the future. To achieve this, we must invest in early childhood education, practical programs, defined career paths, and authentic opportunities for young people and women to engage in this sector—not just as technology users, but as leaders, innovators, and solution creators. Environments that offer training, mentorship, and hands-on experience with modern technologies effectively cultivate national talent, empowering them to lead this field with confidence and proficiency.

**What are the most prominent challenges facing the future of cybersecurity in the region and globally?**

The future of cybersecurity presents evolving challenges and significant opportunities to enhance our preparedness and develop resilient protection systems. As digital transformation and AI integration advance, we must focus on investing in talent, fostering innovation, forming partnerships, and improving governance models. Rather than viewing cybersecurity solely as a threat, we should see it as a strategic opportunity to build a more trustworthy and sustainable digital environment, enabling progress in our rapidly changing world.

**What is the most serious cybersecurity scenario that worries you in the coming years?**

The most concerning scenario involves a sophisticated cyber-attack on critical infrastructure combined with disinformation campaigns, supply chain disruptions, or the misuse of Artificial Intelligence. Such threats undermine public trust, service continuity, and the speed of recovery. This underscores the need for proactive resilience investments, partnerships, and enhanced preparedness at both institutional and societal levels.

## Panel Discussions at ISNR 2026



The 9th edition of the International Exhibition for National Security and Resilience (ISNR 2026) will feature a diverse programme of panel discussions addressing community, security, humanitarian, and technology-related issues, with the participation of leading experts, specialists, government entities, and national institutions, as part of efforts to enhance public awareness and reinforce the concept of comprehensive security in all its dimensions.

The panel discussions, organised by the Ministry of Interior, will take place throughout the three days of the exhibition at Hall 11, covering topics related to community security, digital transformation, quality of life, and sustainability, in addition to addressing the challenges associated with modern technology and its impact on society.

The first day of the programme will witness the launch of the “Digital Child Response System” in collaboration between



the Ministry of Interior and Meta, in a step aimed at enhancing child protection in the digital environment and supporting rapid response mechanisms to online threats affecting children and families. The session titled “When Technology Meets Safety” will also discuss the importance of leveraging modern technologies to support protection and safety systems, with the participation of representatives from the Ministry of Interior, Dubai Police General Headquarters, the Telecommunications and Digital Government Regulatory Authority (TDRA), and Meta.

The second day of discussions will focus on community and humanitarian issues, with sessions addressing “The Family as the Foundation of Society” and the importance of building a socially secure environment, as well as highlighting “The Role of the Internal Audit Office in Supporting Strategic Objectives” at the Ministry of Interior. The programme will also feature a specialised session on “International Humanitarian Law”, with the participation of representatives from the Ministry of Interior, Sharjah Police Gener-



al Headquarters, the International Committee of the Red Cross, and Mohamed bin Zayed University for Humanities.

Discussions will continue on the third day with sessions focusing on digital security, quality of life, and environmental sustainability, through topics including “Role of Family and Digital Safety”, “Quality of life security”, and “Environmental Safety and Protection”, with the participation of several government and community entities, including the Ministry of Climate Change and Environment and the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime.

The sessions will also address topics related to traffic safety awareness, physical fitness, and community readiness, contributing to the promotion of community wellbeing, enhancement of quality of life, and support for community sustainability. The panel discussions at ISNR 2026 reflect the exhibition’s vision of expanding the concept of security to encompass social, humanitarian, and technological dimensions, while strengthening cooperation among government institutions, the private sector, and society to address future challenges and build safer, more sustainable communities.



## Abu Dhabi Police Demonstrates its AI and Smart Security Capabilities

The Abu Dhabi Police General Headquarters is showcasing its advanced smart security systems and innovative technologies at the International Exhibition for National Security and Resilience (ISNR 2026), which commenced today at the ADNEC Centre in Abu Dhabi. The exhibition will run until May 21.

This participation reflects the commitment to enhancing the preparedness of police and security operations for the future while keeping pace with global advancements in security, safety, emergency response, and crisis management.

### Smart Security

The Abu Dhabi Police pavilion showcases a comprehensive array of smart projects, systems, and advanced technological solutions, highlighting the strong integration among the security, traffic, technology, and awareness sectors. It also features various strategic partners from organisations focused on security, emergency response, civil defence, and hazardous materials management. Within the security pavilion, visitors can explore a selection of advanced systems and initiatives, including the Disaster Victim Identification Team, the Security Event Management System (WEB-EOC), digital awareness programmes aimed at drug prevention, and the “Aman” plat-

form, which is dedicated to fostering community engagement and facilitating the reporting of crimes and security risks.

### Traffic Innovations

Abu Dhabi Police is showcasing innovative solutions for road safety, including a traffic awareness platform, a smart robot, and the “Holox” device, all aimed at achieving “Smart Road Safety.” The pavilion features an AI system for city traffic management, drone flight simulations, and a virtual training platform with engaging CGI video presentations. Also highlighted are unique initiatives like accredited qualifications for K9 units, a smart board for collaborative presentations, and the “Bader” project for educational awareness. Attendees can participate in demonstrations with K9 teams, drones, and advanced technology vehicles, as well as training courses on traffic point systems.

### Emergency Preparedness

The Abu Dhabi Hazardous Materials Management Center is showcasing advanced systems, including the “Raqeeb” patrol vehicle, the “Adham” platform, and 3D displays illustrating the lifecycle of hazardous materials and appropriate handling methods. Additionally,

the Emergency, Crisis, and Disaster Management Center is presenting an informational platform that highlights its systems and mechanisms for coordinating and responding to emergencies and crises.

The Abu Dhabi Civil Defence Authority is also participating with a variety of modern equipment and systems, featuring field intervention motorcycles, drones, virtual reality systems, the “RAAD” patrol vehicle, and smart preparedness systems. Furthermore, they will be conducting awareness initiatives and interactive scenarios for the public.

Visitors to the exhibition are encouraged to participate in the “Awareness Arena,” featuring brief introductory sessions and interactive educational content to enhance community awareness and promote a culture of prevention.

# Falcon Eye Cyber Security & Clari5



Falcon Eye Cyber Security and Clari5, a company under Perfios, are participating in the International Exhibition for National Security and Resilience (ISNR) 2026, taking place at ADNEC Centre Abu Dhabi from May 19-21.

During their participation at ISNR 2026, the two companies will unveil a strategic alliance aimed at strengthening fraud prevention and financial crime defences for banks across the Middle East and Africa, amid the growing convergence of cyber threats and financial crime targeting the banking sector.

Cyberattacks and financial crime have increasingly become interconnected threats for financial institutions. A phished credential can lead to synthetic identities, while SIM swaps enable account takeovers. Despite these evolving risks, many banks across the region still operate cybersecurity and financial crime functions separately, without

a unified defence structure. The partnership between Falcon Eye and Clari5 aims to address this gap through an integrated protection framework.

Under the alliance, the two companies will offer banks a unified service combining cybersecurity and Enterprise Financial Crime Management. Falcon Eye specialises in governance, risk, compliance, and security operations, while Clari5 provides a real-time platform for enterprise fraud prevention, anti-money laundering, and behavioural detection. The partnership addresses three major operational challenges facing regional banks: isolated investigations without a shared evidence trail, increasing regulatory requirements for unified reporting controls, and the direct impact of cyberattacks on financial transactions, which demands rapid detection and investigation capabilities. The alliance also provides fraud and compliance teams with an integrated toolkit.

Falcon Eye's I-See workstation analyses digital evidence, while Clari5 Maestro enhances investigations through advanced voice analytics for multiple fraud scenarios. Their combined case management platform integrates transaction trails, customer profiles, and evidence from cyber forensics, voice forensics, and financial crime investigations.

Chandan Ahuja, CEO of Falcon Eye Cyber Security, said the partnership delivers a unified approach to cybersecurity and financial crime management, enabling banks to streamline detection, investigation, and regulatory reporting through a single partner.

Dhruv Manga, CRO of Clari5, said the convergence of fraud and cyber threats has become a major challenge for banks, adding that the collaboration helps improve investigation efficiency and shorten the gap between an attack and transaction recovery.
